

Rules for using Vale Botanical Park

The Botanical Park is an environment that provides leisure, education, health, recreation, and culture to its visitors, providing contact with nature in an extensive green area. Thus, to make your visit more pleasant, certain rules should be observed:

- Vale Botanical Park opening hours are Tuesday through Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m..
- Loud sound is not allowed, out of respect to the environment and the people who share this space with you.
- Nothing should be taken from the Park. Plants, rocks, fruits, and seeds found there are part of the environment and should remain there.
- Nothing should be left at the Park. All garbage must be deposited in appropriate places, always observing the selective garbage collection.
- Pets are not allowed in the Park, as they could cause problems for the wildlife.
- Entering the Park with bicycles, skates, skateboards, scooters, drones, and other similar equipment is prohibited, as well as using balls in the Park area.
- Consuming alcoholic beverages is not allowed in the Park.
- Pamphleting and/or advertising is not allowed.
- Celebrations of any kind that do not comply with the picnic rules in the Park are not allowed.
- The hiking trails should be scheduled, and are always carried out under the monitoring of the Park's Environmental Advisor.
- To walk the trails, visitors should be properly dressed (closed shoes without heels, sneakers, or boots).
- Respect the hours of your scheduled and guided visit to the Botanical Park, so that other people can also enjoy this leisure option.
- Fire, barbecuing, hunting, fishing, and camping are prohibited in the Park.
- Bathing suits are not allowed in the Park.
- Always follow the guidance of the team responsible for the Botanical Park administration.
